



Dear Parent/Guardian,

On Friday 13th May 2022, Cantell will be holding a 'Cantell Culture Celebration Day'. This event will celebrate the wide diversity of cultures that come together to form our Cantell community.

During the course of the day, there will be the opportunity for students to hear live music from different cultures, taste food from different cultures, learn about other cultures as well as celebrate their own. Events will be running throughout the day, during social times, Lesson A and at the start of Lessons.

As part of our celebrations, your child can come to school dressed in either of the following:

- Their traditional cultural dress; that is sensible attire to wear for a day of learning in school
- In clothes that represent an element of their culture,
- Dressed in colours associated with their culture and heritage.

We are aware that for some this request may not be easy to action therefore students may come to school in non-uniform of their choice that is sensible attire for a day of learning.

Students who are wearing cultural dress should refrain from being in any associated accessories to avoid these items being lost or damaged during the school day. Alternatively, students may bring in a picture of such items to share with their peers during Lesson A time.

Please note, that for the food tasting we will be clearly sharing all the ingredients contained in the food on offer, along with the relevant allergy information. It is important that if your child has an allergy that you speak with them about their role and responsibility in keeping themselves safe should they wish to visit the food tasting area and try one of the samples on offer.

Students will be briefed in more detail about the day during their Lesson A slot on Monday 9th May.
