Coursework Component One- Key Skills

Experimenting with cyanotypes, getting familiar with digital sketchbook, uploading, saving, folder management etc.

Learning parts of the camera. What makes a good photo- compositional skills: Rule of 3rds, Leading lines, framing, Depth of field, Tone, Texture, colour, movement etc

Summer Term

Coursework Component One- Exploring themes within Photography

A portfolio that in total shows explicit coverage of the four assessment objectives. This will be completed through the exploration of a range of themes from movement/ light painting, Urban Landscape, Macro and Portraiture. Students will analyse the work of photographers and artist's to inspire their own personal responses, using different camera settings, digital editing and physical manipulation.
